## Weekly Footfall 110,000

Aberdare is an industrial town in the Cynon Valley area of Rhondda Cynon Taff, Wales, at the confluence of the rivers Dare and Cynon. Aberdare is 20 miles north-west of Cardiff and 22 miles north-east of Swansea. Aberdare, during its boom years was considered a centre of Welsh culture; it hosted the first National Eisteddfod in 1861, again in 1885 and in 1956 at Aberdare Park where the Gorsedd standing stones still exist
